What does the Local Plan give us?

3,000+ new houses

15 Traveller pitches

1 questionable *relief* road

250+ acres of lost Green Belt - *equivalent of 165+ football pitches!*

1 much needed 3-form Primary School

2 sports facilities disrupted and relocated

Irreversible ecological damage

100% of development is on our green belt

But no clear guarantees on provision for:

Doctors • Dentists • Local shops • Commuter train capacity

Secondary schools • Car parking • Local public transport

Affordable housing • Cycle ways ...and the list goes on!

Is this what Billericay needs or deserves?

What happens next?

May / June	Regulation 19 public consultation
October / December	Examination in Public
March '19	Plan formally adopted
